



Top Bounce Tennis Wet Weather Policy

At Top Bounce Tennis, we understand that our climate often brings rain—whether it's warm rain in the summer or cold rain in the winter! However, tennis is a year-round sport that can still be enjoyed outdoors, even in rainy conditions, if the courts do not become overly puddled or slippery. We know that sometimes session's will not be able to go ahead and so we factor this in when planning our annual programme.

Light Rain and Showers

In the event of light rain or showers, sessions will likely continue. We regularly monitor the weather using the Met Office app to ensure conditions remain safe for play.

Cancellation Notice

If we decide to cancel a session due to weather conditions, we will notify players at least one hour before the session start time. If you have not heard from us, you can assume the session is going ahead as scheduled.

Unplayable Weather During a Session

Should the weather become unplayable during a session, we will assess the conditions and may postpone the session if it is deemed unsafe to continue. If less than half of the session has taken place before the session has been called off, we will offer a make-up session later in the term, after the end of your course.
